

Mobile Banking Instructions for Android

In order to use Glass City FCU's Mobile Banking application with your Android device, you must be enrolled in [Home Banking](#).

Downloading the Mobile Banking Application

To download Glass City FCU's Mobile Banking application, search for 'Glass City FCU' from Android's Market. The full name of the Mobile Banking application is called 'Glass City FCU Mobile Banking'.



Registering the Android device

1. On the Android device, follow this menu path: Settings -> About Phone -> Status. Make note of the MEID/IMEI number, as you will need this later in the registration process. Please see page 2 of these instructions for information regarding which MEID/IMEI number to use for registration.

NOTE: Depending on the device that you have, the menu path to find your device's MEID/IMEI number may be different from what is shown above, but it should be similar.

2. Log in to [Home Banking](#).
3. Once logged in to home banking, click the 'Mobile Banking' link in the top menu bar.
4. On the Mobile Banking registration page, click the 'Android' radio button, as shown below.



5. In the 'Device ID' box, enter in the device's MEID/IMEI number as found from Step 1.
6. In the 'Mobile No.' box, enter in your Android device's phone number in the following format: XXX-XXX-XXXX *NOTE: This step is optional.*
7. Once all information has been entered, click the 'Register' button. You should see a new section at the bottom of the Mobile Banking registration page similar to below, but with your Android device's information.

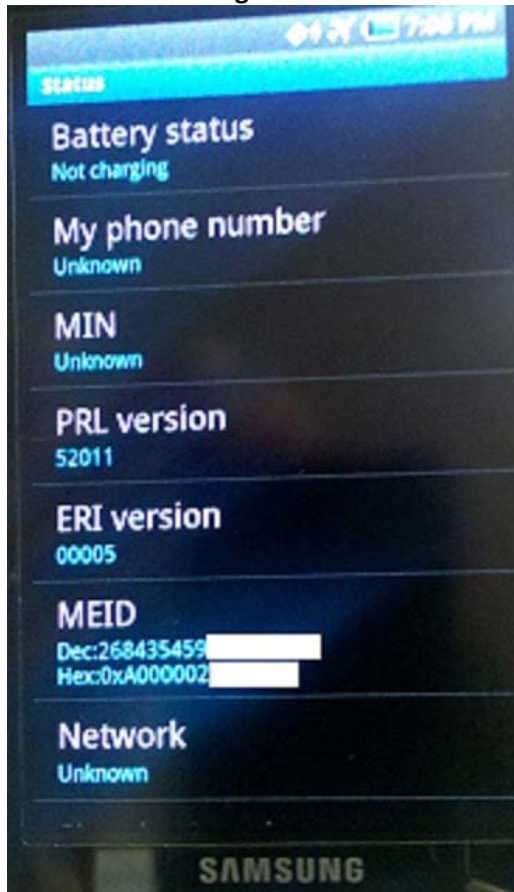

8. You can now log in to the Mobile Banking application on your Android device using your Glass City FCU member number and Home Banking password.

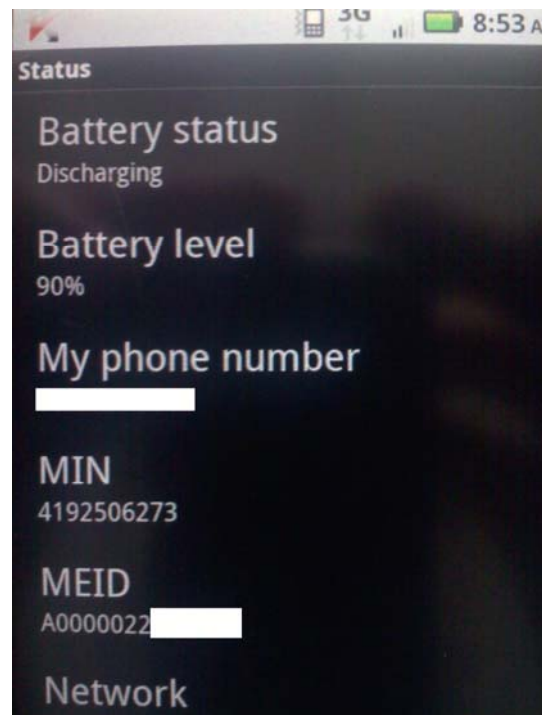
Selecting the correct MEID/IMEI number for registration

Various vendors of Android devices can have different methods in listing the MEID/IMEI number. Below are examples from a Samsung device and a Motorola device. Some of the information in the examples below have been blocked out for security purposes.

Samsung device



Motorola device



In the Samsung example, if your device has **either** a Dec or a Hex number listed for the MEID number, please use that number for Step 5 of the instructions on page 1. If your device has **both** a Dec and a Hex number listed for the MEID number, please use the **Hex** number for Step 5 of the instructions on page 1.

NOTE: If the Hex number begins with '0x' (like it is shown above in the Samsung example), **do not** include the '0x' when entering in the Device ID for Step 5.

In the Motorola example, if your device only has one number listed for the MEID, please use the entire number for Step 5 of the instructions on page 1.
